

Course Description

History-changing battles, great poets and statesmen, classic art and architecture, and a language that was heard throughout most of the known world. In Latin 1, you read the opening credits of this epic movie. In Latin 2, the plots and the characters that populated ancient Rome will come alive.

In this course, you will build on your knowledge of Latin grammar and vocabulary. In the process, you'll sense the beauty of the language and the passion of those who spoke it. Roman engineering, art, commerce and system of laws were all supported by a clear, expressive and flexible language - a language in which you will be able to communicate.

This course will give you a solid grounding in the structure of the language. It will also give you a clear lens for looking into the heart and majesty of the Roman spirit.

This is a yearlong course consisting of 9 units. Upon successful completion students will receive 1 credit towards high school graduation.
